OVERVIEW

uni 2 beyond is an innovative and award-winning initiative that supports people with intellectual disability to experience university life at the University of Sydney. Students attend lectures and tutorials of their choice as audit students, and participate in university social life through engagement with their peers.

In addition to attending university, students undertake internships. Through doing this, students are able to explore their career interests, gain a richer understanding of their strengths, and sharpen their work related skills, preparing them to be productive members of the workforce.

STRUCTURE

The internship program consists of a 6–8 week part-time placement (hours negotiable). The intern will have access to support from a uni 2 beyond workplace facilitator for the full duration of the internship.

Resources and support provided by uni 2 beyond include:

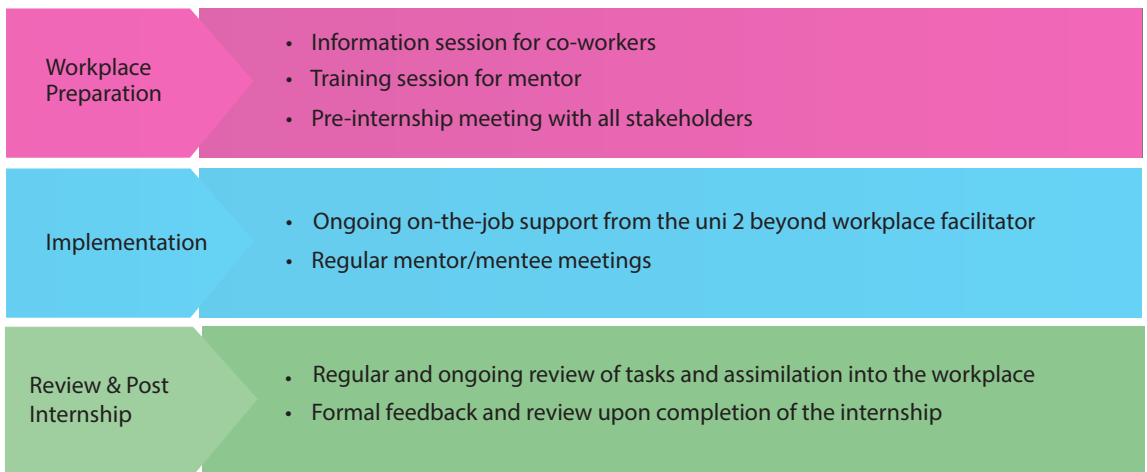
- support for the full duration of the internship
- training for a workplace mentor
- workplace information session

Resources required from the Internship Partner:

- workplace liaison contact
- appointed mentor – time commitment approx. 2 hours for training and 1 hour per week over 6 weeks
- workplace resources as required e.g. access to work station, computer
- payment of 6–8 weeks wages for intern (approx. \$1500)
- optional: Contribution toward the cost of internship support (suggested range \$2000–\$5000)

uni 2 beyond, in accordance with JobAccess (Australian Government) recommendations, provides multi-level structured supports to ensure smooth and successful assimilation into the workplace as outlined below.
