Therapy Assistance

CDS staff can help you to achieve your therapy goals by working with your:

- Occupational therapist
- Speech pathologist or
- Physiotherapist

Improved daily living

Develop the skills you need to be independent (e.g. getting ready for the day, cooking or cleaning).

Increased social and community participation

Provide skills-based learning to develop your independence in accessing the community (e.g. assisting you to join in activities you enjoy).

Improved relationships

Support to help you implement your behaviour support plan.
